## Memorial Flag Protocol

The new memorial on the green is dedicated to the people of Hill Croome Parish, '*Past, Present and Future*' and provides for a place of Remembrance and Contemplation.

The Union Flag is to be flown at full mast, subject to the following conditions/circumstances:

1. National Protocol for the flying of the flag and its position (full, half-mast) to take precedence. Guidance to be established from the appropriate authority.

*Eg. Passing of the monarch or other state occasion or circumstance as directed.*

2. To recognise the passing of a member of the community of Hill Croome Parish.

The flag to be lowered to half-mast when the information is received for a period of 24hrs. Where possible, the flag will again be lowered on the date of the funeral. It will be restored to full mast the following day.

3. Remembrance Day – 11<sup>th</sup> November annually.

The flag is to be lowered to half-mast at 10.30am, restored to full mast following the Act of Remembrance at 11.03hrs.

4. Damaged flag / pole.

In the event, that either the flag or pole is damaged or otherwise unserviceable the flag is to be withdrawn pending repair or replacement.
